Dear Seward Parents/Guardians,

Our Covid positivity rate of students and staff this week is 0.12% which is down from last week's 0.18%. This percentage equates to 2 students/staff testing positive out of 1700 students and staff. We had 0.18 % of our students/staff out on quarantine or isolation this week, which is down from 0.47%. This is a downward trend we hope to see continue.. The Four Corners Risk Dial is at 1.83, which is in yellow.

The governor's risk dial based on the hospital bed capacity within our state is in green. Today the hospital bed occupancy is at 341, which is down from last week.

We need to continue to slow the spread of the virus and what we do collectively is imperative. Please do your part as parents and community members. Together we are making a difference. Continue to avoid the Three C's.

1. Crowded Places. Avoid gathering in groups where you can't maintain 6-foot distance from others.
2. Close Contact. Wear a mask or maintain a 6-foot distance when you're with people you don't live with.
3. Confined Spaces. Avoid enclosed spaces with poor ventilation.
