Dear Parents/Guardians

In a press conference that was held yesterday afternoon the governor and commissioner of education extended the time frame in which schools in Nebraska could not conduct classes in person until April 5. This time frame in which schools in Nebraska cannot have kids in their buildings will be evaluated each week and we will communicate any changes to this timeframe if they are made.

As a reminder, Seward Public Schools will begin its remote learning tomorrow. Please give kids, yourself and our staff grace during this time as we are all doing our best during this difficult time. If you need support or have questions I have attached a PDF that lists the name and number of staff that can support you.

Lunch will be provided for all students whose families qualify for free and reduced lunch. Lunch service will start on Wednesday, March 18th and will be offered daily while school is not in session. If you would like to receive a lunch for your child, please call your child's school office by 8:30 AM starting on Wednesday. If you would like your child to receive lunch every day school is out, let the secretary know and it will not be necessary to call every day. To access your lunch please drive down the alley/road directly west of the High School. We will distribute lunches from the area near the parked vans. You are free to stay in your vehicle and a staff member will get the lunch for your children. Lunch will only be distributed from 11:30-12:00.
